- to address unemployment among young adults in DuPage County by guiding them into good careers, and
- to provide a pipeline of fresh talent for manufacturing in DuPage County.

Why Manufacturing?

Contrary to popular belief, manufacturing is not dead – there are good jobs in manufacturing. However, a career in manufacturing does require interest in technology, and technical and/or mechanical aptitude.

Did You Know?

- 1. Overall, manufacturing jobs pay 16% more than non-manufacturing jobs.
- 2. Manufacturing allows you to work with your hands, and with your head.
- **3.** It is estimated that there are 3,468 manufacturing companies in DuPage County.
- **4.** As older workers retire, manufacturers are eager to hire a new generation with the right attitude, and then train them on the job.
